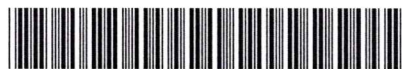

Acting in accordance with La. Const. Art. V, Subsection I, and the inherent power of this Court:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Due to the potential for hazardous weather conditions and freezing precipitation tomorrow morning the Judicial District Court, Parish of Calcasieu, State of Louisiana and the Calcasieu Parish Clerk of Court's office shall be closed on Tuesday, January 16, 2024. Due to the lack of water pressure to the downtown buildings by City water after the freeze, the Judicial District Court remained closed all day on Wednesday January 17, 2023 and the Clerk of Court's office closed at 1:00 p.m.

These closures shall be considered legal holidays in accordance with LSA R.S. 1:55.

If the weather continues to indicate that the Court and Clerk of Court's office should remain closed beyond Wednesday, January 17, 2023, notice of the closure will be posted on the Court's website (www.14jdc.org), the Clerk of Court's website, the Louisiana Supreme Court website (www.lasc.org) and in the news media.

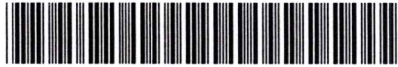

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROCLAMATION OF
STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service is monitoring a winter mix that will impact the State of Louisiana from Monday, January 15, 2024, through Wednesday, January 17, 2024;

WHEREAS, The Honorable Jeff Landry, Governor of the State of Louisiana, issued an Executive Order on January 12, 2024, declaring a State of Emergency to exist in the State of Louisiana;

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service anticipates freezing temperatures and dangerous wind chills to be felt in the Parish of Calcasieu; and

WHEREAS, immediate emergency action may be required to minimize the potential effects to persons and property in the Parish of Calcasieu.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anthony L. Bartie, Calcasieu Parish Police Jury President, by the authority vested in me by the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act of 1993, La.R.S. 29:721 et seq., do hereby proclaim a State of Emergency to exist in the Parish of Calcasieu due to anticipated weather conditions and that all Emergency Preparedness plans have been activated. It is further announced that Richard J. Gremillion has been designated as the point of contact for all responsible activities related to this emergency.

THIS PROCLAMATION ISSUED THIS 15TH DAY OF JANUARY, 2024, AND EFFECTIVE AT TIME OF ISSUANCE.
