EXECUTIVE ORDER 2021-05

**WHEREAS**, due to the potential threat of heavy rains, flooding, high winds, power outages, and widespread property damage due to Hurricane Ida within the Parish of Calcasieu, it was determined that immediate emergency action was required to minimize the potential risks of damage to human life and property, and a Local Government Proclamation of Pending State of Emergency was issued on Friday, August 27, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, the Parish of Calcasieu is in need of emergency action, support, and funding to respond to said property damage due to Hurricane Ida, and said Proclamation declared a State of Emergency to exist in the Parish of Calcasieu and all Emergency Preparedness Plans were activated, and Richard J. Gremillion, Director of the Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, was designated as the point of contact for all response activities relating to this emergency;

**WHEREAS**, a meeting was held on Friday, August 27, 2021, with local officials, including the Calcasieu Parish Sheriff, and it was agreed that a voluntary evacuation order of the Parish of Calcasieu is appropriate for the protection of the citizens of the Parish.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Brian Abshire, President of the Calcasieu Parish Police Jury, by the authority vested in me by the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act of 1993, which may prevail, do hereby impose an order for the voluntary evacuation of the Parish of Calcasieu.

This Proclamation issued on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2021, and effective at time of issuance.
